II. ACTIVITY DETAILS:

1) SELF HELP GROUP PROMOTION, LINKAGES AND STRENGTHENING:

SAHAYOG is working for women's socio-economic development through formation of women's SHG's. Grass Root Level women SHG's are formed, skills of organization and basic managerial skills are imparted to help them to work with issues they face on day-to-day basics. At the end of the financial year ending 31st March 2020, the total villages covered under SHG promotion activities are 69 in four Taluka's of Bidar District.

a) Bank Linkages:

During the year 2019-2020. SAHAYOG has linked their 25 SHG's to bank for 3rd Time Loan and 09 SHG's for 4th Time Loan. At the end of the financial year ending 31st March 2020 the Total SHG credit linked to bank for 1st Time Loan is 284. 4) WOMEN'S EMPOWERMENT TRAINING:

The overall empowerment of women was an ongoing process throughout the functioning of SHG's. Each of the SHG meets once every week. The total weekly meetings conducted from all the SHG's promoted by the organization is in the tune of 14570.

In addition to the primary agenda of saving and thrift activity, the group were facilitated to take up the agenda on the issues of their concern like their health, the atrocities committed against women, the issue of un-touch ability practiced in the area, denial of access of public services, education of their children. The issue relating to dissertation of women in their villages. The role of women Panchayat Raj System, the staff who were present in the meeting provided information and helped them to work with the issues on hand. This process was helpful for the women to gain confidence and standup to their rights.

5) CHILDLINE 1098 PROGRAMME.

During the year 2019-20 SAHAYOG has continued the CHILDLINE Sub Centre at Bhalki with the support of CHILDLINE India Foundation and has successfully planned & conducted the following CHILDLINE activities.

10) HEALTH AWARENESS, PROGRAMME:

During the year 2019-2020 SAHAYOG has conducted 1 health camps, at Village Chitta, Bidar Taluka on 14-09-2019. 84 women, men and children's were participated in health awareness camp. The theme include the common ailments, water bound diseases, special health needs of women especially of girl children. The programme was followed by health screening and referral services. The local medical professionals were invited with one private consultant to conduct the camp.

11) DISPLAY OF HOARDINGS ON CHILD LABOUR.

During the Year 2019-20 SAHAYOG has taken responsibility of Displaying hoardings in all the 8 taluka's of Bidar District. In each taluka 2 hoardings are displayed in front of Govt. Offices & Public Places on the issue of Child Labour. Supported by Bidar District Child Labour Rehabilitation Society.

12) WALL WRITING ON CHILD LABOUR.

During the Years 2019-20 SAHAYOG with the help of Bidar District Child Labour Rehabilitation Society, has taken a Responsibility of Wall Writing on Child Labour, Accordingly SAHAYOG has Written Wall Writings on Child Labour Issue. In Bidar Taluka 7, Bhalki 6, Humnabad 6, Basvakalyan 6, Aurad 6. Totally 31 wall writings on Child labour issue written in the S.T Street & Colony.



13) LAND RIGHTS OF URBAN DEPRIVED COMMUNITIES.

During the year 2019-20, SAHAYOG in association with MAARG Karnataka has conducted the following activities on Land Rights in Bangalore Slum Area's as follows:

a) Follow up with the Land & revenue administration in Bangalore District. 1000 filled & pending application submitted more than a year ago for claiming the land rights of the urban deprived in many different slums spread all over Bangalore

b) Two Community Level Training workshop for intervention in the protection of urban Land commons

c) Filling RTI's & follow up by the Community Members on the land recovered by the KLPC.

d) The other programmes includes community Leaders Convention, Community Level consultation, community awareness Buildings in slums, Land Rights Convention & capacity Building Workshops for leaders.

14) AIR POLLUTION & TRAFFIC CONGESTION.

During the 2019-20 SAHAYOG as part of the Green Grants Fund (GGF) project following is the list of activities conducted during the period April 2019 to December 2019 in Bangalore. The following activities carried during the period as follows:

a) Conducted air Quality governance summit for City Action Plan in Bangalore by involving Various Stake holders such as government, researchers, Scientist, Bus Commuters & Slum Dwellers.

b) Conducted Public Meetings with elected officials & bureaucrats, Pollution Boards & environment Department with whom the Children's as a clean air ambassadors will represented & Demanded the implementation of an action Plan for Air Pollution Mitigation.

c) Conducted Children's rally against Air Pollutions by involving 200 School Childrens with posters & Play Cards.

d) conducted interviews with Dalit families to learn about their perspectives on environment & Air Pollution and also conducted experimental mapping of Citizen views on Air Pollution & Traffic congestion.

e) Prepared Air Pollution Awareness Booklet.

15) DISABILITY AWARENESS PROGRAMME.
